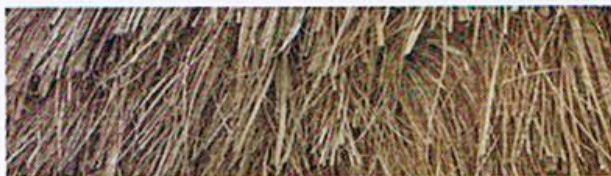

Castaway's Marina (The Square Grouper)

- At Castaway's, or as the locals call it - Square Grouper, you don't have to go to the Bahamas that tropical feeling. There are only a very few places in our own backyard that deliver that true 'island' feel. Sit back, relax, drink a cold cocktail and enjoy a refreshing ocean breeze blowing on your face. Castaway's is the bar first famous by Alan Jackson and Jimmy Buffett, where the superstars filmed on-location their number one hit song "Five O'Clock Somewhere." The bar sits directly on the coastal Waterway, across from the Jupiter Lighthouse. A view - especially at night! Comfortable chairs and tiki torches are plentiful. You'll be walking on soft beach sand, so be careful ladies with those high heel shoes. A live band plays on Friday and Saturday nights. And if you want to blend in with the locals, throw on a pair of flip flops. The bar serves food such as hotdogs, hamburgers and chicken wings, and plenty of libations including beer, wine, and those tasty, tiki quenching tropical frozen drinks. The bar's a little tricky to find, but well worth the effort. It's located approximately one mile north of the intersection of Indiantown Road and A1A in Jupiter. At A1A and Indiantown Road, go north on A1A for about one mile, make a right on Love Street, then go all the way to the end of the street and you're there. Hint... if you see the lighthouse, it's almost directly south of it on the other side of the water. Now look at your watch, isn't it five o'clock where? Located at 1111 Love Street in Jupiter. Cruzan Rum Bar

Head back to the Islands at the Cruzan Rum Bar in Palm Beach Gardens. You'll see everything from tiki torches, coconut palm trees, tiki bars, fire pits and tropical drinks. It makes this bar one of Palm Beach County's coolest hangouts. If you have a boat, no problem, pull up to the dock and you're there. You'll be walking on beach sand that covers the entire property.
